It was very well attended, it was lovely to see so many of you there.

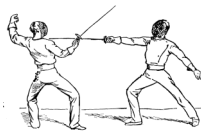
As always, we appreciate your continued support.

Both the children and the staff looked fantastic in their costumes.

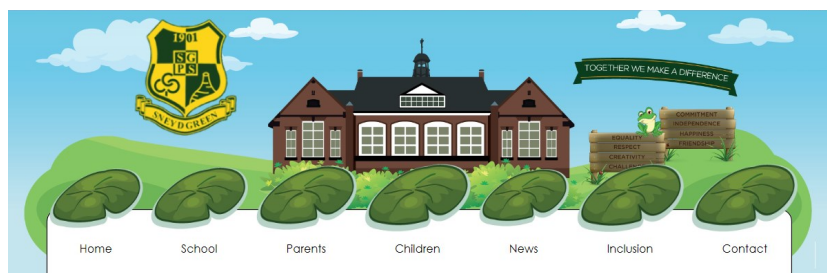
As you know, the children were given the opportunity to take part in a book swop. During the day a total of 131 books were swopped in school.
