The draw will be made on Thursday next week.

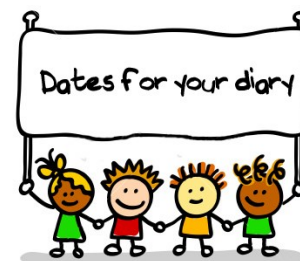
